## **Creating Confidence In Your High Street**

We are working to ensure your market town can trade safely and effectively again from the government's set date of June 15.

Working closely with town councils and the county highways department, our plans have been developed at considerable pace. They strike a balance between the need for us to keep people safe, by enabling them to follow the guidelines whilst out and about, and our desire to ensure footfall returns to pre-Covid levels as quickly as possible.

### **Changes to roads and footpaths**

Making some changes to roads and footpaths will be necessary if we're to make town centres safer for shoppers, and the wider community.

In some cases, it may be necessary to divert traffic to alternative routes or restrict certain access. We will ensure deliveries can still be made, car parks remain open and accessible, and blue badge holders can park centrally.

Where the above changes allow it, increased space outside businesses can be used for enhanced displays, additional seating for hospitality businesses and for public enjoyment. This will be supported by a relaxation of licencing etc.

### **Making the streets clean and safe**

We will be installing hand sanitising units at points throughout the town centre.

### **Signage and street furniture**

We will be installing extra signage, including signs on lampposts and distance markings on pavements to remind people of distancing measures.

We will also be installing extra seating and planters in some areas.

### **Cycling and parking**

We are installing extra bike racks in a bid to encourage more people to bike into town, however cyclists will be required to dismount in pedestrian priority areas.
